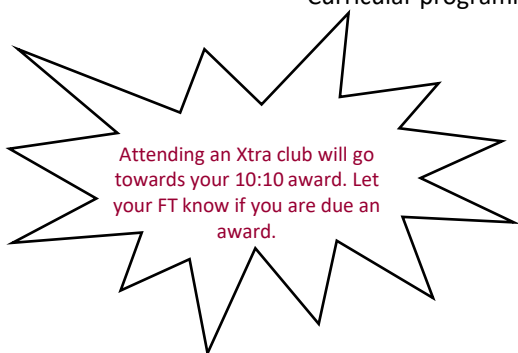




As part of our commitment to the holistic growth and development of students, we are delighted to announce our brand new Extra-Curricular programme known as Saint Aidan's Xtra.
